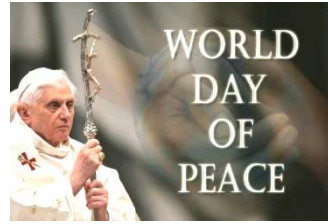


THE FEAST OF THE EPIPHANY
