FROM THE PAGES OF HISTORY

The present Church of St. Thomas Aquinas in Bromby Street was originally opened as a chapel of ease on the 21st February 1915 by Archbishop Carr. The chapel was reconstructed with a new facade in Spanish Mission style in 1954 and blessed by Archbishop Mannix on the 30th September 1954. The architect lived in Bromby Street in latter years and recalled that the coloured enamel tiles decorating the entrance were fired in brickworks located at the intersection of Toorak Road and Chapel Street.
