The Parish Council in South Yarra was one of the earlier such bodies to be established in the Archdiocese after the Second Vatican Council. The Council is currently constituted by the parish clergy and pastoral team as "ex officio" members and

A President and Vice-president are elected from the group. The Council meets ten times a year to discuss, plan and implement parish policy and events from our worship to social events and charitable works.
